This agreement is between Barefoot Labradors and the individual(s) stated above, herein after referred to as "Buyer." In consideration of payment in full of the purchase price of \$ _____ (plus \$ _____ CT Sales Tax), Barefoot Labradors agrees to transfer to the Buyer, subject to the terms and conditions contained in this agreement, the ownership of one Labrador Retriever puppy, herein after referred to as the "Puppy," from the mating of the sire and dam identified above.

1. All puppies are sold with Limited Registration.

“Limited Registration” means that your puppy can be registered with AKC, but no litter produced by the dog is eligible for registration. Dogs with Limited Registration may not be entered in breed competition at Dog Shows but may compete in all other AKC events. The litter owner may later apply to change this designation to full registration privileges but a fee and special application are required.

The Buyer can request Barefoot Labradors to re-evaluate the puppy as a breeding prospect and to change the limited registration to a Full Registration once an acceptable OFA and CERF certification is completed after the age of two.

2. It is understood that, at the time of sale this puppy has been evaluated by the breeder with respect to other representatives of the breed at approximately the same

age and has been determined to be structurally and temperamentally suited to be a companion, hunting, and/or obedience dog. While we strive to produce the best possible puppy, this does not necessarily imply that the dog is of breeding or show quality.

Health Guarantee

3. This puppy is guaranteed to be healthy upon delivery to the Buyer, and a full refund will be given for any puppy found to be unhealthy within 7 days of purchase, provided the following is met. Failure to comply with and provide documentation of these requirements voids all guarantees.

1) Buyer must have new puppy examined by a licensed Veterinarian within 7 days.

If the puppy is found to be ill, the breeder is to be notified within 24 hours and a refund of the purchase price will follow the return of the puppy and all papers to the breeder, including a written statement from the attending veterinarian stating the dog's condition.

2) If the puppy/dog is due for vaccinations, and the Buyer(s) fails to provide vaccinations on time, this guarantee is null and void if the puppy contracts diseases that would otherwise be prevented by those vaccinations.

3) Buyer(s) warrants that the puppy will be kept in appropriate conditions for its health and welfare. The puppy will be fed a suitable diet for its age and condition. Puppy will receive all necessary veterinary care to maintain its good health.

Hereditary Defect Guarantee

4. The Barefoot Labradors represents and warrants the following to the original purchaser until the dog reaches 30 months of age: (Barefoot Labradors cannot warrant the following if the pup is overweight and/or has had improper nutrition, excess exercise, accident or injury that may alter the results)

We guarantee that this puppy is free of the following hereditary defects as defined below:

a) Dysplasia of the hips and elbows to such extent as to be certified acceptable (fair, good, or excellent) by the Orthopedic Foundation of Animals (OFA) at/until thirty months of age. Such certification from OFA must be obtained at the expense of Buyer.

b) Hereditary defects in the eyes are guaranteed until thirty months of age. This certification can be registered through the Canine Eye Registration Foundation (CERF). A certified Canine Ophthalmologist certificate is required along with full medical history from date of purchase to present for replacement.

There is no warranty regarding the fertility of the above described animal.

5. There is no absolute guarantee that a breeding program can be fully certain that no problems will develop. There are a variety of hereditary defects that are found in all animals. We warrant our puppies for only the defects for which we can screen the parents: hips, elbows and eyes. We do not provide warranty for other hereditary defects. If such a heredity problem of hip/elbow/or eyes is diagnosed (with nothing else being the cause) a quality puppy shall be given to the Buyer out of the next available litter. It is not required that Buyer return the dog to collect on this warranty, but the Buyer must provide proof of spay/neuter within a reasonable amount of time. The Buyer must give notice of the defect in writing to Barefoot Labradors from a licensed veterinarian. Barefoot Labradors reserves the right to have the dog examined by their vet. Veterinarian records of the dog must be supplied from the time of purchase that includes any/all injuries, weight at periodic checkups, and all shot records.

The above described puppy is warranted to the original owner or owners only. Transfer of ownership nullifies and voids this warranty. It is understood that the above warranties are expressly regarding inherited congenital defects of hips, elbows and eyes. Any physical injury or abuse to the dog voids this guarantee. Breeding of dog in lieu of spay/neuter by four to six months will void the warranty.

Other:

6. As a responsible a breeder, we expect that this puppy will be properly socialized and attend a puppy obedience classes. As breeders, we do everything possible to breed dogs of sound mind (temperament) and body. The rest is the responsibility of the Buyer(s) such as proper feeding, exercise, socializing and training, of which all have a bearing on the end results of a sound adult dog.

7. If for any reason the Buyer is unable to care for or keep the animal, the Buyer must advise Barefoot Labradors, who will have first option to repossess the dog. Barefoot Labradors agrees to assist in efforts to find a new home for the dog, regardless of its age.

8. The Buyer(s) agrees to and understands(s) the following conditions: The puppy shall not be sold, leased or given to any pet shop or research establishment. Buyer(s) further agree that said puppy should not be used for medical or any other experimental purposes or sold/donated to supplier, wholesaler, shelter, pound, or humane society.

9. This contract contains the entire agreement between us and any statement or verbal agreements made by either party that are not contained in this written contract shall be not be valid or binding. This contract may not be modified or altered except in writing and signed by both parties.
